Greetings from Tayoltita! I hope this letter finds you well. I can't believe it has been already a month since I got here. It has been a very busy month. The first week I got here, a Discipleship Training School Team from YWAM New Castle, Australia was also here. There were 5 students in the team and very eager to work.

We conducted kids' evangelism activities during the day and door to door evangelism in the camp a couple of evenings and had a chance to pray for people. One of the nights, we showed a movie and five people came to the Lord. We also prayed for healing for some people. The team was very helpful with house chores and one of the guys in the team even built a table! I so appreciated their hard work and patience with the kids.

I continued with camp visits the following week. The kids at the camp have been busy working on a Spanish coloring book that has Bible stories. They have been doing great and I am excited to report that the kids are paying good attention to the Bible stories and have won special prizes for answering the questions I asked them as I read the stories to them.

Brother Quintin (Kent) from Texas and Roberta from Oaxaca also spent a week here. Brother Kent was able to minister to some people from Chiapas who speak the Tzeltal Indigenous Language. We visited with them at their home a couple of evenings. We worshiped and shared a short bible message with them. Roberta and I worked with the kids every day that week and had a raffle for the kids that attended Bible story times that week. We also had three salvations during movie night that week.

Last Monday, my friends Ole and Vicki were here from Canada came to visit. We all went to the camp for Bible story time. The kids love visitors so Ole and Vicki were busy playing with the kids. They brought lots of school supplies and stuffed animals for the kids.

This last Sunday during service, we had a young man from Oaxaca who accepted the Lord. He also plays the guitar!! I have been praying for someone to help out with the worship. Pray that he keeps coming.
